

INFORMATION REGARDING A HORSE PRE-SALE CLINICAL EXAMINATION



1. When selling a horse through an online auction organised by the platform Arabian Horse Treasury, a horse pre-sale clinical examination must be conducted on the basis of the Protocol available on the website (www.arabianhorsetreasury.com). The examination must be conducted by a veterinary surgeon.
2. The horse owner may commission the examination to any given veterinary surgeon. The examination will be conducted based on an agreement solely between the horse owner/official horse owner representative and the veterinary surgeon performing it.
3. The Protocol will be filled out by the veterinary surgeon in the English language. We kindly ask for clear, legible handwriting and recommend using printed, capital letters or filling the form out on a computer - an editable pdf. file is available for download on the website.
4. A part of the Protocol involves an interview with the horse owner/official horse owner representative and it must be signed by them as a way of verifying the data given.
5. We kindly ask that any comments with observations or remarks about the examination be written in the appropriate part of the Protocol. Any and all observed anomalies should be described.
6. The horse owner/official horse owner representative is responsible for delivering the completed Protocol to the Arabian Horse Treasury in the way specified by the procedures of registering a lot for auction.
7. The protocol will be published on the horse's offer page, in the exact way it was filled in by the veterinary surgeon and passed on by the horse owner/official horse owner representative.
